Health-supported housing fills a service gap, addressing the intertwined crises of housing instability, access to care, and SUD in Arizona, recognizing their profound impact on maternal and child health.

Our housing facilities are in walkable, mixed-use neighborhoods with access to public transportation, parks, and healthy food. CDC Public Health AmeriCorps members deliver evidence-based Seeking Safety interventions supporting recovery, maternal and child resiliency skill-building activities, and transportation services ensuring access to care.
